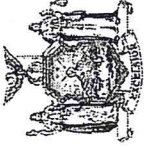

A local law relating to the local dog license fees for the Town of Amity

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the

Section 1 - Title
The title of this local law shall be, "Local Dog License Fee Law of the Town of Amity".

Section 2 - Purpose
The Town Board of the Town of Amity finds that the Town is required to provide a dog control officer and pound or shelter services, pursuant to Article 7, Section 114 - 115 of the Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York. The purpose of this local law is to set local fees for the licensing of dogs, in addition to the statutory fees, to maintain and provide these services so required.

Section 3 - Authority
This local law is enacted pursuant to Article 7, Section 106 and Section 110, Sub-division 4 of the Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York, effective January 1, 1980 and October 1, 1979, respectively.

Section 4 - Definition of Terms
As used by this local law, the following words shall have the following meanings:
(A) Agriculture and Markets Law - The Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York, Article 7: Licensing, Identification and Control of Dogs.
(B) Town - The area within the Town of Amity, including the Village of Belmont, where dogs are harbored or kept.
(C) Clerk - Means the Clerk of the Town of Amity, who validates or issues dog licenses.
(D) Dog - Means any member of the species canis familiaris.
(E) Guide Dog - Means any dog that is trained to aid the blind and is actually used for that purpose, or any dog owned by a recognized guide dog training center located within the state.
(F) War Dog - Means any dog which has been honorably discharged from the United States Armed Services.

(If additional space is needed, please attach sheets of the same size as this and number each)

(G) Police Work Dog - Means any dog owned or harbored by any state or municipal police department or any state or federal law enforcement agency, which has been trained to aid law enforcement officers and is actually being used for police work purposes.
(H) Regular License - Agriculture and Markets Form DL 1, which provides for the licensing and identification of dogs.
(I) Purebred License - Agriculture and Markets Form DL 15, which provides for the licensing of one or more purebred dogs registered by a recognized registry association.

(J) Statutory Fees - Dog license fees pursuant to Article 7, Section 110, Sub-division 1, 2 and 3 of the Agriculture and Markets Law.
(K) Local Fees - Additional fees charged by the Town, pursuant to Article 7, Section 110, Sub-division 4 of the Agriculture and Markets Law.

(L) Harbor - Means to provide food and shelter to any dog.
(M) Owner - Means any person who harbors or keeps any dog.

Section 5 - Local Fees

The Town of Amity will charge a local fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00), in addition to the statutory fee for each regular or purebred dog license.

(A) No regular or purebred license will be issued unless payment of the local fee is made with the application for said license.

Section 6 - Notice of Local Fees

A notice of the local fees set forth by this local law shall be presented to each dog owner at the time of enumeration. A notice of the local fees shall be posted in the office of the Town Clerk.

Section 7 - Exemption to Local Fees

(A) No local fee shall be charged for any guide dog, war dog or police work dog, providing identification documents are presented to the clerk with the license application.

Section 8 - Effective Date

This local law shall take effect December 1, 1981.



TITLE: A LOCAL LAW RELATING TO THE LOCAL DOG LICENSE FEES FOR THE TOWN OF AMITY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF AMITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1 - TITLE

THE TITLE OF THIS LOCAL LAW SHALL BE, "LOCAL DOG LICENSE FEE LAW OF THE TOWN OF AMITY".

SECTION 2 - PURPOSE

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF AMITY FINDS THAT THE TOWN IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A DOG CONTROL OFFICER AND POUND OR SHELTER SERVICES, PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 7, SECTION 114 - 115 OF THE AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK. THE PURPOSE OF THIS LOCAL LAW IS TO SET LOCAL FEES FOR THE LICENSING OF DOGS, IN ADDITION TO THE STATUTORY FEES, TO MAINTAIN AND PROVIDE THESE SERVICES SO REQUIRED.

SECTION 3 - AUTHORITY

THIS LOCAL LAW IS ENACTED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 7, SECTION 106 AND SECTION 110, SUB-DIVISION 4 OF THE AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1980 AND OCTOBER 1, 1979, RESPECTIVELY.

SECTION 4 - DEFINITION OF TERMS

AS USED BY THIS LOCAL LAW, THE FOLLOWING WORDS SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING MEANINGS:

- (A) AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS LAW - THE AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, ARTICLE 7: LICENSING, IDENTIFICATION AND CONTROL OF DOGS.
- (B) TOWN - THE AREA WITHIN THE TOWN OF AMITY, INCLUDING THE VILLAGE OF BELMONT, WHERE DOGS ARE HARBORED OR KEPT.
- (C) CLERK - MEANS THE CLERK OF THE TOWN OF AMITY, WHO VALIDATES OR ISSUES DOG LICENSES.
- (D) DOG - MEANS ANY MEMBER OF THE SPECIES CANIS FAMILIARIS.
- (E) GUIDE DOG - MEANS ANY DOG THAT IS TRAINED TO AID THE BLIND AND IS ACTUALLY USED FOR THAT PURPOSE, OR ANY DOG OWNED BY A RECOGNIZED GUIDE DOG TRAINING CENTER LOCATED WITHIN THE STATE.
- (F) WAR DOG - MEANS ANY DOG WHICH HAS BEEN HONORABLY DISCHARGED FROM THE UNITED STATES ARMED SERVICES.
- (G) POLICE WORK DOG - MEANS ANY DOG OWNED OR HARBORED BY ANY STATE OR MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENT OR ANY STATE OR FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, WHICH HAS BEEN TRAINED TO AID LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND IS ACTUALLY BEING USED FOR POLICE WORK PURPOSES.
- (H) REGULAR LICENSE - AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS FORM DL 1, WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE LICENSING AND IDENTIFICATION OF DOGS.
- (I) PUREBRED LICENSE - AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS FORM DL 15, WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE LICENSING OF ONE OR MORE PUREBRED DOGS REGISTERED BY A RECOGNIZED REGISTRY ASSOCIATION.
- (J) STATUTORY FEES - DOG LICENSE FEES PURSUANT OT ARTICLE 7, SECTION 110,

SECTION 7 - EXEMPTION TO LOCAL FEES




