Local Law No. 1 of the year 1991

A local law To reschedule the dates for the filing of the tentative assessment roll and the hearing of complaints by the Board of Assessment Review. (Grievance Board)

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Amity as follows:

Whereas: The Town of Amity utilizes a sole appointed assessor pursuant to Local Law No. 1 of 1989, and

Whereas: The sole appointed assessor acts on behalf of several other assessing units, and

Whereas: The sole appointed assessor will be unable to attend the hearing of complaints by the Board of Assessment Review on the date prescribed by New York State Real Property Tax Law, Section 512 (1)

Therefore be it resolved:

that pursuant to Real Property Tax Law Section 576 Subdivision 3, the date for filing of the tentative tax roll for the Town of Amity will be May 1st and the hearing of complaints by the Town of Amity Board of Assessment Review will be held on the fourth Tuesday of May.

Section : Application

This local law shall supersede in its application to the Town of Amity, Section 512 (1) of the Real Property Tax Law.

Section : Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of New York State.
