That pursuant to Real Property Tax Law Section 576, the date for filing of the tentative tax roll for the Town of Amity will be May 1st and the hearing of complaints by the Town of Amity Board of Assessment Review will be held on the first Tuesday of June or such date as shall be adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Amity if there is found to be a conflict.

Section 1: Application

This local law shall supersede in its application to the Town of Amity, Section 512 (1) of the Real Property Tax Law, and shall repeal Local Law No. 1 of the year 1991 of the Town of Amity.

Section 2: Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of New York State.
